Introduction To Flintknapping

This class will consist of an hour's morning lecture and a video on the history of flintknapping, the concepts behind how it works, and use of the materials involved. After a one-hour lunch break, there is an afternoon session devoted to working hands-on with stone and flintknapping tools.

Students should be sure to dress for spending time outdoors, wear eye protection and gloves (glasses or sunglasses are OK, or safety glasses will be provided), and should not wear shorts or open-toed shoes. This activity generates very sharp edges, and exposed flesh can receive a cut.
