Navajo Weaving Workshops

Saturday & Sunday 9 am to 1 pm



Nanabah Aragon is a traditional Dine (Navajo) weaver who was declared a “living treasure” by the State of Arizona. Her weavings have been on display at the Heard and Smithsonian museums. She will teach you the basics of Navajo weaving as you create your own sample and learn the techniques passed on from Nanabah’s mother and grandmother.

* Workshops are limited to 6 people.

Class fee: \$85.00 plus \$30.00 refundable deposit for a 12” x 15” hand loom plus weaving tools. You will need 2 to 3 skeins of wool yarn in your choice of colors.
